As per Eureka City Ordinance No. 06-14-21-1, An Ordinance amending the City's Ordinance regulating the licensing and control of dogs and other animals within Eureka City Section 13-244 License and Registration Required.

- It is unlawful for any person to keep, harbor or maintain **any dog or cat** six or more months old unless such animal has been registered and licensed with Eureka City.
- Kennel Licenses are required for anyone that has 3 or more dogs over the age of 3 months.

Rabies Clinic

Eureka City and Central Utah Animal Hospital will once again sponsor the annual Rabies Clinic on Saturday May 21, 2022 from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm at the Public Works Building, 401 West Main Street, Eureka, Utah. **All dogs and cats are required to be registered and licensed in Eureka.** Anyone that has 3 or more is required to obtain a Kennel License through the City Council. It is unlawful to allow animals to run at large or to be on private property. You can familiarize yourself with the ordinance by visiting the City's website:

place all garbage (old or broken flower pots, plastic flowers, etc) that have been cleaned off the lots into the dumpster just outside the entrance gate. All tree limbs or brush that is removed from the lots may be placed in the limb pile up behind the cemetery on the North West side. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT GARBAGE IN THIS LIMB PILE!!** It is for limbs and brush only.

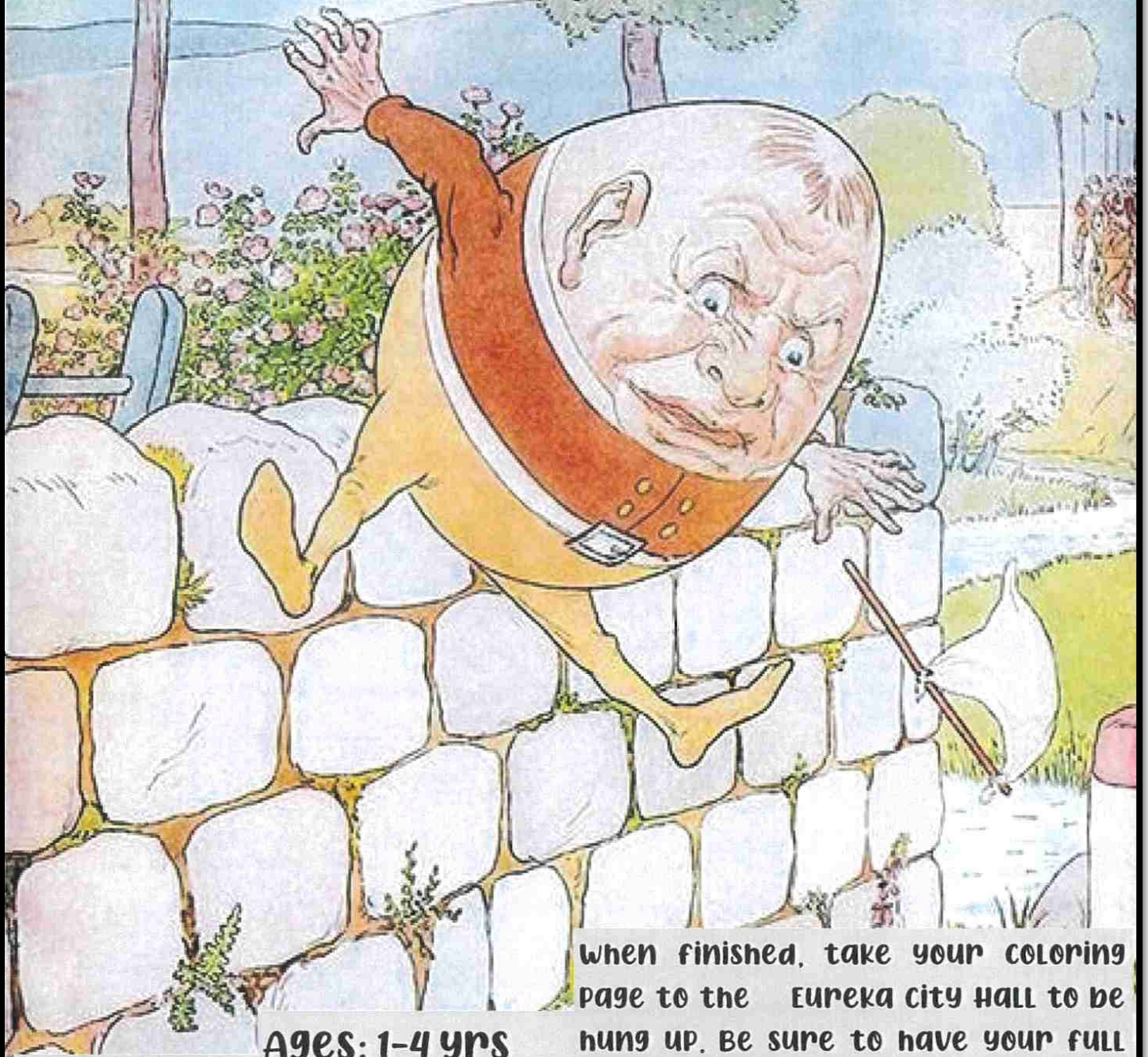
